About Special Event Tickets

Participants with a valid meal plan at the time of a ticketed event are eligible for one discount ticket. If coming only to attend a special event, register as a Guest. Tickets are available as "will call" in the Registration Office in Hunsaker Center.

Meal Plans

Meal plans are available for pre-purchase to participants in Section D of the online registration. Choose the one that best fits your schedule. Purchase one when registering.

- Meal Plan A - Wednesday breakfast to Sunday breakfast (13 meals, fits Hawaii group travel): **\$143.00**
- Meal Plan B – Wednesday dinner to Saturday dinner (10 meals, fits California travelers arriving Wednesday for Orders or Opening Worship): **\$112.00**
- Meal Plan C – Wednesday dinner to Saturday dinner, NO BREAKFAST (7 meals, fits schedule of hotel guests, lunch and dinner only): **\$83.50**

Half-price meal plans are available to children under the age of 12. Increased prices reflect the increased length of the Session and a \$0.75/day increase in base cost over 2016.

Where to Eat

Irvine Commons provides buffet-style meals three times a day from breakfast on Wednesday June 14 through breakfast on Sunday June 18. Purchase a meal plan or pay cash at the door (\$9 for breakfast, \$11.25 for lunch or dinner).

Children under the age of 12 eating in the Commons with their parents may eat for half-price.

Conference participants are welcome in Commons at 6:30 AM for breakfast, 11:30 for lunch and 5:00 PM for dinner.

The Plaza Café is open during the day for quick a la carte purchases. Cash only, no meal plans.

Campus Residence Halls & Apartments

Housing policies are contained in full in Section F of the online registration. Please read carefully when you register. Housing is available on campus for \$31 / night (ages 12 and older), \$15.50 / night (per child ages 6-11), and \$0 / night (per child 5 and under, registration is still required). Linen sets can be rented for your stay for \$16.50. Campus housing is designed and intended for university students. Most housing is double occupancy and those staying on campus can expect a roommate. No University housing offers private bathrooms. By staying on campus, you agree to be financially responsible for any damage to your room for which the Conference is charged by the University, including lost keys, linens, pillows or additional cleaning. All guests staying on campus must check out and return keys by 10:00 AM on Sunday June 18, 2017. If you are scheduled to check out on Saturday, you may return your keys any time through 10:30 PM in Hunsaker University Center. **If you do not wish to stay on campus, local hotels are available. Brockton Apartments: air-conditioned, 2 bathrooms & 4 single bedrooms per apartment. Kitchen & living space. High demand for this space. Availability is not guaranteed.

California Hall: air-conditioned, no ground floor rooms, community bathroom w/ one gender / floor. Double occupancy. Located on the Quad.

Cortner Hall: air-conditioned, jack-and-jill bathrooms, double and triple occupancy, first priority for Hawaii travelers. Located on the Quad.

East Hall: air-conditioned, community bathrooms located throughout each floor, mixed occupancy (single & double). Located near Orton Center.

Founders Hall: air-conditioned, jack-and-jill bathrooms, double occupancy, limited ground floor rooms. Located on the Quad facing Colton Avenue.

Melrose Hall: air-conditioned, community bathrooms (1 for each gender per floor), double occupancy, no ground floor rooms. Priority for early arrivals. Located on the Quad.

Merriam Hall: air-conditioned, community bathrooms (1 for youth, 1 for young adults per floor), double occupancy. **Youth, chaperones, and young adults only. One gender per floor.**

North Hall: air-conditioned, community bathrooms (1 for each gender per floor), double occupancy. ClergyMate activities are located in the lounge. Located on Brockton Avenue.

Williams Hall: air-conditioned, community bathrooms located throughout each floor, mixed occupancy (single & double). Located near Orton Center.
